Alfred W. Ferguson, 91, of Ridge Road, Broadalbin, passed away on Sunday, July 16, 2023, at the Wells Nursing Home in Johnstown.

He was born in Broadalbin on April 30, 1932, a son of Alfred and Lila Donnelly Ferguson and was attended school in Broadalbin. Al served in the US Army with the 15th Infantry in Korea from 1952-54. He was on the frontline the night of the ceasefire and was honorably discharged as Sgt. 1st Class.
