



Alfred L. Lowry

Alfred L. "Moe" Lowry, 84, of Riceville Road, Gloversville, passed away on Thursday evening, September 14, 2023, at Nathan Littauer Nursing Home.

He was born in Connellsville, PA on July 3, 1939, a son of Harry "Ira" and Margarite Gummerson Lowry and attended school in the Ohio Pyle district. Moe lived in Dunbar, PA until moving to Mayfield in 1956, at age seventeen.

His first place of employment was with Gem Footwear in Gloversville. He later worked at Mohawk Cabinet and Musser Cleaning, both formerly in Gloversville. For more than thirty years, Moe was employed as a machinist at General Electric Co. in Schenectady, retiring in 1994.

Alfred was dedicated to Jehovah in April 1976. He was a longtime member of the Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses in Gloversville and enjoyed ministry work.

Moe enjoyed carpentry and woodworking, gardening, camping, and fishing. He also loved working around his house, completing most projects by himself. Mostly, Moe enjoyed spending time with family and friends.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his siblings, Edna McMillian, Orville Lowry, Dale Lowry, Ewing Lowry, Ira Lowry Jr., and Ruth VanNostrand Handy; and his beloved Boxer, Mugsy.

Survivors include his wife, Gloria VanNostrand Lowry, whom he married on June 29, 1963. Upon their marriage, Moe and Gloria lived on 14 Green Street in Mayfield until 1967 when they moved to Riceville Road. He is also survived by a son, Eric L. Lowry (Kelly) of Northville; a daughter, Michele Hope Lowry Fitzpatrick (Bruce) of Broadalbin; three grandchildren, Kalee, Cody, and Brandon; three greatgrandchildren, Jaydon, Liam, and Poppi Aria; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
