Assunta J. "Sue" Blinsinger, 87, of South Second Avenue, Broadalbin and formerly of Amsterdam, passed away Monday June 22, 2020 at the home of her daughter surrounded by her loving family.

She was born in Amsterdam on August 15, 1932 a daughter of Joseph and Rose Scafidi Natoli and was a 1950 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School. Sue later completed coursework at Spencer Business Institute in Schenectady and excelled in secretarial skills. She was a lifelong Amsterdam resident before moving to Broadalbin six years ago.

Mrs. Blinsinger was proudly employed as a secretary at GE in Schenectady until 1961 when she left the work force to raise her family. When her children were older, Sue worked at the Amsterdam Teachers Association as a secretary and retired in 1990.

Sue was a devoted and faith filled member of St. Mary's Church in Amsterdam and later of St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin.

She loved cooking, playing cards, and traveling. Her favorite destinations included Hawaii, California, the Bahamas, and Cape Cod. These trips were made with family and always filled with adventures and great times.

Sue married the love of her life, Robert G. Blinsinger, on September 28, 1958. They were meant for each other and enjoyed a wonderful life together until his passing on April 3, 2017. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by a sister, Rosemarie Morreale; a sister-in-law, Jeanette Montagnino; and two brothers-in-law, Richard and Ronald Blinsinger.
