



Audrey F. Goebel

August 11, 1941 - October 6, 2024

Audrey F. Goebel, 83, of Sun Valley Road, Gloversville, passed away on Sunday, October 6, 2024, at Nathan Littauer Hospital.

She was born in Gloversville on August 11, 1941, a daughter of the late Howard and Helen Kinney Teetz, and was a 1959 graduate of Gloversville High School. Audrey attended SUNY at Albany and later graduated from Albany Business College. She was a lifelong area resident.

Audrey was a third-generation owner and operator of Glove City Abrading Co. Inc. in Gloversville, for over 20 years with her husband serving as manager. Audrey was an active member at St. James Lutheran Church in Gloversville and later at Grace Lutheran Church in Johnstown, spanning 60 years between both churches where she was a deacon and served in various leadership capacities.

Audrey served as president of the Advisory Board for the Salvation Army in Gloversville and was a longtime member of the YMCA in Fulton County.

Audrey was a member of three quilting guilds, including the Sew Busy Quilt Guild of Gloversville.

Survivors include her husband, Richard F. Goebel, whom she married on June 1, 1963; five sons, Frank Goebel of Menands, Richard Goebel of Newport News, VA, Howard Goebel of Albany, Charles (Amy) Goebel of Gloversville and William (Geraldine) Goebel of Newtown Square, PA; one brother, Michael Teetz of Amsterdam and two step-brothers, Jason and Kevin Teetz of Gloversville; six grandchildren, Brianna, Emma, Jesse, Jack, Derek, and

Jordan; one nephew, Jeffrey Teetz of Montgomery, TX and two nieces, Deborah Szoke of Chico, CA and Kimberly Teetz Coronado of Clearwater, FL. Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. Services will be held on November 29, 2024, at Grace Lutheran Church in Johnstown.
