Benjamin H. Steele, Sr., 88, of State Highway 29A, Gloversville, passed away at home on Sunday, September 7, 2025, with family at his side.

He was born in Gloversville on March 29, 1937, a son of Earl and Ivy Murgittroyd Steele, and attended local schools. Ben was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Steele was employed at Nor-Gas in Johnstown and later worked at Blue Flame Gas Company in Gloversville. He retired in 1999.

Ben served in the US Army and was honorably discharged in 1962.

He was a member of the former Redmen's Club in Johnstown.

Ben enjoyed NASCAR, wrestling, and tinkering with mechanics. He also loved repairing bicycles. Mostly, he loved spending time with family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Ben was predeceased by his siblings, Katherine King, Mary Meher, Robert Steele, and Gene Steele; and his son-in-law, Shawn Dake.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth Hamel Steele, whom he married on April 20, 1958; five children, Sandra (Bill) Hichens of Gloversville, Tammie Dake of Johnstown, Benjamin (Vicky) Steele, Jr. of Piedmont, SC, Kelly (Bob) Walker of Gloversville, and Robert Steele (Marge) of Fonda; eight granddaughters; three grandsons; seven great-granddaughters; five great-grandsons; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
