Bernhard Lenz, 67, of South Shore Road, Broadalbin died Wednesday November 23, 2016 in Little Falls.

He was born in Kleinbulten, Germany on June 9, 1949 a son of Bauer G. and Augustine Krieger Lenz and moved to the United States at age one. Bernie lived on the family farm in Ballston Spa and later moved to Amsterdam where he was educated. He lived in Broadalbin for the past thirty years. Bernie became a US citizen in 1976.

At the time of his death, he was employed as a technician at H & M Equipment in Amsterdam, where he worked for twenty one years.

Bernie was a member of the Adirondack-Catskill Chapter of Safari Club International and the Fish House Fish & Game Club. He enjoyed hunting and fishing and spending time with family and friends.
