Bertha C. Kenyon, 96, formerly of Northville, passed away on Tuesday, October 8, 2024, at Nathan Littauer Hospital Nursing Home in Gloversville. She was born in the Town of Edinburg on November 29, 1927, a daughter of Ernest and Clara Muehlenhaupt Tange and attended school in Edinburg and Northville. Bertha was a lifelong area resident.

Mrs. Kenyon enjoyed doing housekeeping for several local families, who became her close friends. Later in life, she provided in-home care to elderly friends.

Bertha loved to cook and was famous for her hot potato salad. She loved to crochet, and she loved fast cars and wolves. Most of all, she loved spending time with family and friends. A memorable trip included an Alaskan cruise with her family nearly 10 years ago. At age 96, Bertha was still active with social media using her tablet and phone.

Bertha was married to Arthur Kenyon in 1946. Sadly, he died in 1999. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by a stepdaughter, Janet Kenyon; and her siblings, Dorothea, Augusta, Vivian, June, Beulah, Ernest "Junior", Nicky, and Camilla.

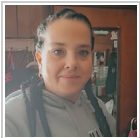

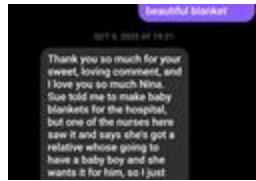
