Bette E. Errig, 86, of Crooked Street, Broadalbin, passed away on Wednesday, July 9, 2025, at Mountain Valley Hospice in Gloversville, NY. She was born in Hackensack, NJ on October 19, 1938, the daughter of Harold and Edith Olson Blair, and was a 1956 graduate of Hackensack High School. Bette graduated from Montclair State University in 1960, earning a Bachelor's degree in education. She later received a Master's degree in education from Hofstra University.

Mrs. Errig began her career in education as a physical education teacher in Lindenhurst, Long Island. Later, she served as a teaching assistant in Hauppauge, Long Island followed by working in the South Country School District as a special education teacher. Mrs. Errig retired as an assistant principal for the district in 2000.

Bette also enjoyed teaching guitar from her home.

Mrs. Errig was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Amsterdam and served as a deacon. She enjoyed creating newsletters for the church.

Bette did volunteer work for several local organizations. She also loved traveling and making photo books of her travels.

In addition to her parents, Bette was predeceased by a brother, Craig. Survivors include her husband, Charles W. Errig, whom she married on June 25, 1960; four children, Charles (Jessica) Errig of Newfoundland, PA, Christina (Christopher) Napoli of Flemington, NJ, Cathleen (Ian) Meyers of Atlanta, GA, and Cindy (Mark) Makarowsky of Broadalbin; and eight

grandchildren.
