



Brian D. Opalka

August 29, 1972 - December 29, 2019

Brian D. "Bo" Opalka, 47, of Van Dyke Avenue, Amsterdam, passed away at home on Sunday morning December 29, 2019, following a long, inspirational, and courageous battle with brain cancer.

He was born in Amsterdam on August 29, 1972, a son of Donald and Judith Przybylowicz Opalka and was a 1990 graduate of Broadalbin-Perth High School. Brian attended FMCC and HVCC and was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Opalka was employed as the store manager at Ace Hardware in Amsterdam for 20 years before retiring due to illness.

Brian's determination and strength were evident in his never waning ability to face life and his medical challenges without complaint. His children were his most rewarding accomplishment. Together they had an incredible bond filled with humor and love.

He was predeceased by his father, Donald, a nephew Jeffrey Opalka, Jr., grandparents Steven and Sadie Opalka, and William Przybylowicz.

Survivors include his wife, Karen Cichy Opalka, whom he married on July 5, 1996. They were best friends, soulmates, and inseparable. He is also survived by three sons, Alec, Matthew, and Braydon Opalka; a daughter Kaylin Opalka,

all at home; his mother Judith Opalka of Amsterdam; two brothers, Jeffrey Opalka of Fort Johnson and Kenneth (Ronda) Opalka of Valrico, FL; his maternal grandmother Edna Przybylowicz of Hagaman; several aunts, uncles, cousins and nieces.

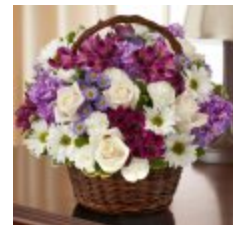
