Carol Ann. Barras, 74, of Fish House Road, Galway, passed away at home on Friday, January 13, 2023. She was a loving mother, grandmother, sister, and friend.

Born in Glens Falls on December 24, 1948, Carol was a daughter of Glen and Pearl Walker Pepper and the stepdaughter of Roland Lemery. She attended school in Galway. She was a lifelong area resident and often spent winters in Brooksville, Florida.
