Charles L. Smith, 72, of McQueen Road, Town of Perth, died Friday morning December 5, 2014 as a result of a structure fire at his residence.

He was born in Amsterdam on August 2, 1942 a son of Fahey and Carmita Rankie Smith and was a graduate of the Wilbur H. Lynch High School. Charlie was a veteran of the US Army. He was a lifelong area resident.

He was employed as a machinist at General Electric Co. in Schenectady for twenty eight years, retiring due to disability in 1995.

Mr. Smith was elected a Town Justice in Perth in 1979 and served the community for twenty five years. Later, he served as a councilman for the town.

Mr. Smith attended the Cranesville Reformed Church. He was a member of the Fulton County Republican Club, and a member and past president of the NYS Magistrates Association.

He enjoyed woodworking and reading, especially westerns and murder mysteries. Mostly, he enjoyed spending time with family and friends.

Survivors include his wife, the former Michol E. Natale, whom he married on November 24, 1973; three sons, Thomas Palamer, of Appomattox, VA, Aaron D. Smith (Jennifer) of Broadalbin, and Micah C. (Angela) Smith of Hagaman; a daughter, Amanda (Jarrod) Skinner of Perth; two brothers, Donald (Pat) Smith of Fort Meyers, FL and Robert (Vikki) Smith of Amsterdam; a brother-in-law, David (Rhonda) Natale of Amsterdam; seven grandchildren; and several nieces , nephews, and cousins.

Cremation will be performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. Calling hours will be held on Wednesday at the Robert M. Halgas Funeral Home, Inc. 111 County Highway 106 (Corner of Route 29 & Black Street) Johnstown from 4 – 7 pm. Final burial will take place at Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Amsterdam at a later date. 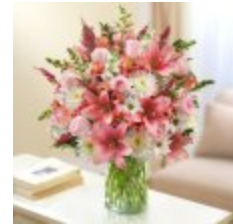
