



## Daniel A. Denison

April 15, 1947 - March 31, 2025

Daniel A. Denison, 77, of Yuma, AZ and formerly of Galway, NY, passed away on Monday, March 31, 2025, at his son's home in Weatherford, TX.

He was born in Amsterdam on April 15, 1947, a son of Kenneth and Beatrice DesRoches Denison and was a 1966 graduate of Galway High School. Dan lived in Galway for several years and moved to Yuma, AZ twelve years ago to enjoy his retirement.

Mr. Denison served in US Air Force and was honorably discharged in 1970. He later served as an airplane mechanic for 34 years with 109th Stratton Air National Guard Base in Scotia, retiring in 2002.

Dan was a skilled plumber, electrician, and builder. He was instrumental in establishing Denison Construction, which is operated by his son, Michael. He was a member of the American Legion and enjoyed stopping by the posts in New York and Arizona.

Dan loved spending time with his family and friends. He spent time playing cards with the guys and always looked forward to his annual trip to visit his sons. Dan drove from AZ to TX to NY and would make the return trip when the weather got cold. He made sure to be in Texas for Thanksgiving dinner, which he so enjoyed.

Survivors include three sons, Michael Denison (Kimberly Bott) of Duanesburg, Marshall (Bridget) Denison of Weatherford, TX and Marc (Summer) Denison of Hagaman; four grandchildren, Kenneth (Carla) Denison, and Ethan (Xiann) Denison, and Sierra and Sadie Denison.
