Dave was a 1964 graduate of Mont Pleasant High School in Schenectady and after high school, enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps. He served honorably during the Vietnam War and was discharged in 1967.

Mr. Blesser was employed by General Electric Co. in Schenectady as an Inspector for many years until his retirement in 2002.

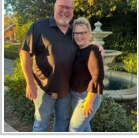
