David A. Brooks, 74, formerly of Broadalbin, died peacefully at home surrounded by love on Wednesday, July 15, 2015.

He was born in Amsterdam, NY on October 17, 1940, a son of Frank and Stella Brooks and was a graduate of Broadalbin Central School. David attended Fulton Montgomery Community College and served in the Air National Guard in Schenectady, NY. He worked hard all his life as a Fulton County Sheriff's Deputy, a Youth Division Aide at Tryon School, and an Emergency 911 Coordinator for Citizens Communications in Johnstown, NY.

David was a devoted member of the Broadalbin Kenneyto Fire Department for thirty five years, serving as an Officer for thirty years, and Chief for twelve years. He was a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus.
