



Domenico C. Di Grazia

April 16, 1966 - February 8, 2024

Domenico C. Di Grazia, 57, of Gloversville, passed away on Thursday, February 8, 2024, at Ellis Hospital in Schenectady after battling pancreatic cancer for 17 months.

He was born in Rome, Italy on April 16, 1966, a son of Nicola Di Grazia and Marianna Bianco. In 1976 he moved to America with his family and lived here for five years. He went to Kingsborough School, Estee Middle School, and Gloversville High School. Then the whole family returned to Italy, and he finished his schooling at ITC Andrea Torrente, where he obtained an accounting diploma. He moved back to the United States when he was 23, acquired his citizenship, and resided in Gloversville for the past 34 years.

Dominic immigrated here to pursue his American dream. To pursue his dream, he worked at many jobs while attending college. His goal was to become a foreign language teacher because he had a tremendous love for languages. He was a graduate of FMCC, SUNY Albany, SUNY Buffalo. As his favorite language was French, he spent two years in Grenoble, France to submerge himself into the language.

Mr. Di Grazia spent 27 years in the public education system. He worked at many different school districts, but his most recent one was Mayfield Central School where he taught Spanish, Italian, and French. He retired in June 2023 due to illness.

His first love was his family and friends. He loved everyone near and far. He enjoyed his special seat on the cabana, watching the birds in his backyard. He

also loved gardening, woodworking and sharing that love with his sons. He always enjoyed cooking, sharing all his Italian traditions and entertaining family and friends. He was a world traveler and he loved to experience things from different cultures.

Mr. Di Grazia was a member of the Church of the Holy Spirit in Gloversville. This church held a special place in his heart because this is where he married his devoted wife. It also was the church that performed all the sacraments on his three beloved sons.

He was predeceased by his father, Nicola.

Survivors include his wife, Jamie Lauritano Di Grazia, whom he married on December 30, 2006; three sons, Nicola R. Di Grazia, Damiano S. Di Grazia, and Matteo F. Di Grazia, all of Gloversville; his mother, Marianna Bianco of Arzano, Naples Italy; two sisters; Paola Di Grazia and her husband, Arcangelo Grieco, Stefania Di Grazia and her companion Gianni Sabella; all of Arzano, Naples, Italy; and a niece and nephew, Martina and Daniele Grieco. He is also survived by his mother-in-law Sandra Lauritano; three sister-in-laws; Theresa Butkevitch, Sharon Dye, her husband Terry, Alicia LaGreca , her husband Leo; and niece and nephews; James and Matthew Butkevitch, Sara Dye, and Anthony LaGreca.
