



Donald A. "Andy" Keller

February 24, 1962 - November 27, 2025

Donald A. "Andy" Keller, 63, of Galway, passed away on Thursday, November 27, 2025.

He was born in Niskayuna on February 24, 1962, a son of Arthur and Emmerette Kile Keller. Andy was a graduate of Galway High School and later earned a degree in Criminal Justice from Fulton-Montgomery Community College. He was a lifelong area resident.

Andy was employed by the New York State Department of Corrections in Coxsackie for over 30 years, retiring in 2021.

He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Amsterdam for several years and later of Living Hope Christian Church in Ballston Lake.

Andy was a member of the American Legion and the VFW in Broadalbin, and of the NRA.

Andy was an Indianapolis Colts fan, an avid outdoorsman, and enjoyed motorcycles and boating.

Mr. Keller rendered honorable service in the Army National Guard for 30 years, spending time at several bases including Fort Drum and in Germany.

Andy was predeceased by his parents.

Survivors include his girlfriend, Diane Britton; two brothers, Arthur B. (Patricia) Keller, Jr. and Edward W. Keller, both of Galway; his former sister-in-law, Katherine Keller; a niece, Katelyn Keller (Nathan); and two nephews, Arthur Keller, III (Krystal) and Timothy (Carnan) Keller.

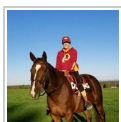

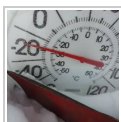
