Dorothy M. Bombard, 92, of North Main Street, Gloversville passed away Tuesday morning August 20, 2019 at her daughter's home in Broadalbin surrounded by her loving family.

She was born in Amsterdam on February 20, 1927 a daughter of Sanford and Magdaline Stangle Sherman and was the valedictorian of the class of 1944 at Galway High School.

Mrs. Bombard was employed as a seamstress at the former Martin Jay Dress Shop in Amsterdam. Later, she was a bus driver for Galway Central School. After moving to Florida, Dorothy drove a tour bus at the Kennedy Space Center.
