Dorothy S. Milnyczuk, of County Highway 106, Amsterdam, passed away Monday, December 11, 2023, at the age of 92.

Dot was born in Amsterdam, the daughter of Charles F. and Marion Bishop Schultz, and grew up in Fort Johnson. She was a 1950 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School in Amsterdam and a 1951 graduate of Mildred Elley.

Dot worked as a legal secretary for many years until becoming a medical secretary at Amsterdam Memorial Hospital for more than twenty years, retiring in 1994.

Dot was a parishioner at St. Joseph's Church in Broadalbin.

She was married to William Milnyczuk on May 1, 1954. Sadly, he died on December 23, 2004.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by a grandson, Justin Milnyczuk.
