Dorothy M. Parker, 88, of Garlock Road, Caroga Lake, passed away at home on Wednesday, June 12, 2024.

She was born in Amsterdam on September 29, 1935, a daughter of Arnold and Barbara Flesch Chaffin and was a 1953 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School. Dorothy was a lifelong area resident and lived in Caroga Lake since 2016.

Mrs. Parker was employed with the Fulton County Department of Social Services for nearly forty years and retired as the supervisor for the Fraud Investigation Unit.
