Douglas R. Steenburg, 72, of Perth, passed away at home on Tuesday, April 19, 2022.

Born in Gloversville on December 14, 1949, Doug was a son of Harold and Helen Van Alstyne Steenburg. He was a graduate of Guilderland High School, class of 1967, and moved to Perth in 1980.

Doug was employed at General Electric Co. in Schenectady for many years, retiring in 1994 due to a disability.

Mr. Steenburg had a talent in restoring muscle cars and was an outdoorsman, enjoying hunting and fishing. He was a former member of the Pine Tree Rifle Club.
