Edward D. Gasner, 74, of Stevers Mill Road, Broadalbin died at home on Thursday evening July 28, 2016 with his loving family at his side.

He was born in Broadalbin on February 2, 1942 a son of John and Helen Donaldson Gasner and attended school locally. Ed was a lifelong area resident.

He was employed as an operating engineer with Lane Construction in Fultonville and was a member of the Local 106. Later, Ed established Gasner's Auto Body in Broadalbin, which he owned and operated for thirty years. At the time of his death, he was the owner and operator of Gasner's Little Acres Mobile Home Park in Broadalbin, which he opened in 1970.

Mr. Gasner was a former member of St. Joseph's Church.

He was an exempt member of the Kenyetto Volunteer Fire Company and was a member of the Masonic Lodge in Broadalbin and Northville.

Ed enjoyed motorcycling, camping, hunting, and ice fishing. Mostly, he loved spending time with family and friends.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a brother, Harold, who died in March.

Survivors include his wife, Virginia Baird Gasner, whom he married on August 27, 1966; a daughter, Wanita Marie (Martin) Gasner-Foley of Hadley; two sisters, Marilyn (Fred) Prahl of New Caney, TX and Margaret (Bob) Cloutier of Jacksonville, FL; a sister-in-law, Joanne Gasner of Broadabin; a step-granddaughter, Brittany Foley; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Cremation will be performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. A memorial service will be held on Wednesday at 10 am at the Robert M. Halgas Funeral Home, Inc. 111 County Highway 106 (Corner of Route 29 & Black Street) Johnstown with Rev. Kathy Reese, officiating. Final burial will be in Broadalbin-Mayfield Rural Cemetery.
