Edward R. Murphy, 77, of Crooked Street, in the Town of Galway, died Tuesday August 4, 2015 at home.

He was born in Amsterdam on July 12, 1938 a son of E. Kenneth and Helen McKenna Murphy and was a 1956 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School. Ed later studied Business Administration and Accounting at Bryant College in Providence, RI and also pursued various studies at Fulton Montgomery Community College.

Mr. Murphy was employed for ten years at Lane Construction Corp. and later as a manager for Santos Construction, Twin Cities Sand, Gravel and Ready Mix, and Building Ventures. He retired in 1992 from the Cranesville Companies.

Mr. Murphy served as chairman of the Galway Planning Board and later as a Town Justice. He was a member of the New York State Magistrates Association, Sons of the American Legion Post #337, and the VFW Post #8690.

He is survived by very close friends who thought of Ed as family; Joyce Keller, his companion, and her children, and James T. Hall, Bruce Hall, Mary McChesney, Nacole Neahr, all of Galway.
