Perth – Edward E. Vickers, Sr., 75, of Perth passed away and joined his family in Heaven on Saturday, November 13, 2021 at his home with his loving children by his side.

He was born in Gloversville on September 16, 1946, the son of the late Edmund and Ruth Frye Vickers and was a graduate of Perth Central School. Ed was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Vickers served in the United States Army from August 15, 1966 until November 30, 1970 when he was honorably discharged.

He worked at Packer's Meats, in Perth and later was Vice President of Bryland Construction, in Albany. Ed was a bartender and bar chairman at the American Legion in Broadalbin. He was a very active member of the American Legion Post 337 of Broadalbin for thirty years and served as Commander, Chaplain, and Adjutant. Ed was also a member of the American Legion Color Guard, a County Commander, District Commander, and a Charter Member of the Saratoga National Cemetery Color Guard.

He enjoyed being with his family for Sunday dinners, working on projects around the house with his children, and riding his motorcycle.

Survivors include four children, Scott Vickers of Gloversville, Edward (Traci) Vickers, Jr., Tammy (Will) Ericson, and Rachel Vickers, all of Perth; five grandchildren, Jessica Vickers, Erica Vickers, Steven Vickers, Courtney Isolda, and Zane Gromyko; and his wife, Phyllis, of Fort Pierce, FL.
