



Edythe P. Montgomery

Edythe P. Montgomery, 93, of Church Street, Saratoga Springs, and formerly of Broadalbin, died Monday afternoon January 11, 2016 at the Wesley Health Care Center.

She was born in Springfield Gardens, NY on September 19, 1922 a daughter of Otto H. and Bertha M. Winkler Wanner and was a 1939 graduate of Far Rockaway High School. Upon her marriage, Edythe lived in Jackson Heights before moving to Wantagh in 1951. She moved to Broadalbin in 1982 where she lived until relocating to Saratoga Springs in 2008.

After raising her children, Mrs. Montgomery worked as a nursery school teacher at the Levittown First Presbyterian Church, where she was a member. While in Broadalbin, Mrs. Montgomery was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

Edythe enjoyed playing bridge with friends, working on crossword puzzles, and classical music. Her greatest delight was spending time with family and friends.

She was married to William J. Montgomery on April 8, 1944. He died December 25, 2007. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by a son, Robert A. Montgomery, who died in 2012, and two sisters, Doris A. Wanner and Gladys M. Agne.

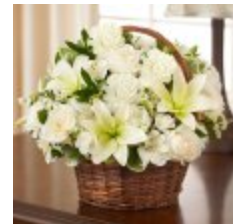
