Elizabeth Anne Kilinski, 79, of Wilds Road, Fort Johnson died Friday morning June 10, 2016 at St. Mary's Healthcare.

She was born in Amsterdam on November 13, 1936 a daughter of Louis and Matilda Beatty Leavenworth and was a 1954 graduate of Broadalbin High School. Anne was a longtime area resident. She spent ten years in Florida and returned to New York in 2001.
