She was born in Niskayuna on January 13, 1952, a daughter of Robert E. and Gertha E. Kamper O'Brien. Ellen was a 1970 graduate of Northville Central School. She proudly served in the US Air Force from 1971- 75 and was stationed at the Plattsburgh Air Force Base.

In 1976, she became a civilian fire fighter for the base before retiring due to illness in 1984.

Ellen will be greeted by those who have gone before her, including her parents, her youngest brother, John O'Brien, her beloved beagle, Frosty Joe, other family members and friends.
