Elsie N. Hayes, 89, of West Main Street, Broadalbin passed away Thursday morning March 21, 2019 at home surrounded by her loving family.

She was born in Broadalbin on October 31, 1929 a daughter of Lester Pettit and Ruby Frye and was educated in Broadalbin. Elsie was a lifelong village resident.

Mrs. Hayes delivered newspapers for the Schenectady Gazette. She had a local motor route and delivered faithfully for over forty years.

Elsie was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Broadalbin.

She enjoyed bowling and was a member of a local league years ago. In recent years, Elsie enjoyed playing bingo. Her family meant the world to her and she was affectionately known as “Grandma with all the kids.” Sunday morning breakfast with the family was important to her. She lived for her children and grandchildren.

She was married to William D. Hayes on April 30, 1947. He died May 22, 1984. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by twin sons, Robert and Richard; a daughter, Lois; four sisters, Genevieve, Carolyn, Ruth, and Evelyn; and three brothers, Lawrence, Gordon, and Donald.

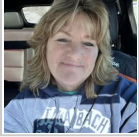
