



Eugene F. Stevens Jr.

October 28, 1943 - May 24, 2023

Eugene F. Stevens, Jr., 79, of Westline Road, West Charlton, passed away Wednesday, May 24, 2023, at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam as a result of injuries sustained in an accident earlier in the day.

He was born in Amsterdam on October 28, 1943, a son of the late Eugene and Eleanor Thackrah Stevens, and was a 1961 graduate of Broadalbin High School. Gene was a longtime Broadalbin resident. He enjoyed wintering in Florida for twelve years before returning to the area two years ago.

Mr. Stevens was employed at Verizon in Schenectady for thirty-three years, retiring in 2003. Recently, he was involved with his son, Erik, at the Great Sacandaga Brewing Company in Vail Mills.

Gene was a veteran of the US Air Force and served during the Vietnam Era. He was a member of the American Legion Post #337, and was a member of the former Rotary Club, both of Broadalbin.

Gene loved the outdoors and enjoyed hunting when he was younger. He was an avid golfer. Mostly, he enjoyed spending time with family and friends.

Survivors include his wife, Martha A. Porter Stevens, whom he married on February 3, 1967; three children, Matthew (Vicky) Stevens of Sierra Vista, AZ, Erik (Jerriane) Stevens of Broadalbin, and Elisabeth (Douglas) Case of West Charlton; a brother, Kevin (Terry) Stevens of Schenectady; a sister, Kathy (Don) Frye of Broadalbin; six grandchildren; two step-grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Cremation was performed at Park View Crematorium, Schenectady. A military

service will be held on Tuesday, June 6, 2023, at 1:30 pm at the Gerald B.H. Solomon-Saratoga National Cemetery, Schuylerville. A procession will leave the funeral home at noon on Tuesday.
