Everett G. Hawes, Jr., 86, of Vandenburg Point Road, Gloversville died Friday November 10, 2017 at Ellis Hospital, Schenectady with his loving family at his side.

He was born on August 1, 1931 in Uxbridge, MA a son of Everett G. and Hattie E. Brousseau Hawes and was a 1950 graduate of Uxbridge High School. Everett later received an Associate's Degree from the New England School of Accounting in Worcester, MA. He moved to this area in 1967.

Mr. Hawes was a veteran of the US Marine Corps and proudly served from 1950-1954.

Everett was employed as an accountant at the Beechnut Baby Food Co. in Canajoharie for twenty five years, retiring in 1995. He then worked for Kasson & Keller in Fonda and after retiring worked for NYS Green Thumb.

Mr. Hawes was a member of the former Sacred Heart Church in Gloversville.

He also was a member of the Knights of Columbus in Worcester, MA.

Everett was a member of the Singletary Rod & Gun Club. He enjoyed hunting and fishing with his family.

Survivors include his wife, Helen Army Hawes, whom he married on December 23, 1950; four sons, Richard E. (Karen Ann) Hawes of Mayfield, Michael T. (Sharon) Hawes of Tucson, AZ, Timothy B. Hawes of Rochester, and Matthew R. (Richella) Hawes of Herkimer; a brother, Leonard Hawes of Center Lovell, ME; eight grandchildren, Darcy Ann, Nathaniel, Kathleen, Melissa, Brian, Spencer, Morgan, and Abigail; five great-grandchildren,

Daniel, Nicholas, Alexandra, Eric, and Hunter; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
