Frank L. Wright, 85, of Brooksville, FL and formerly of Broadalbin, passed away on Friday, June 26, 2020 at St. Mary's Healthcare, Amsterdam, NY. He was born in Amsterdam on September 16, 1934 a son of Albert and Gerda Franke Wright and was a 1952 graduate of Broadalbin High School. Frank lived in Broadalbin for several years and after retiring, he began wintering in Florida.

Mr. Wright was employed at GE in Schenectady and later as a mechanical engineer at the former Mohasco Corp. in Amsterdam. Later he worked at Northeast Stud Welding in Schenectady, retiring in 2003.

Frank enjoyed flying and had a private pilot license. He also loved extensive camping trips with his family. Frank's greatest hobby was remodeling, including homes and RV's, and he also loved flipping his creations.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by a son-in-law, Paul Karabin; and the mother of his children, Alice Tabolewski Wright.
