Frederick "Fred" G. Hallenbeck, Jr., 70, of County Hwy 155, Gloversville died Sunday morning, June 25, 2017, at home.

He was born in Gloversville, on January 30, 1947 to parents Frederick Sr. and Marie Hallenbeck. A lifelong area resident, he graduated from Gloversville High School in 1966

Fred owned and operated Hallenbeck Trucking for many years. He received an award for driving over 2 million safe miles. Once he gave up over the road trucking, he became a coach driver for Brown Coach Inc. He retired from Brown Coach in 2015.

Fred enjoyed his family and friends. He and his wife, Toni, often hosted parties and holiday get-togethers. He loved a good party, especially if dancing was involved. With his own unique style, he would get everyone up and dancing to the music. His daughter, Holli, was one of his favorite dance partners. The two of them were a great combination.

As a young man, Fred was a member of the Broadalbin Kenyetto Fire Company, where his son John proudly followed in his father's footsteps years later. He joined the Broadalbin Bowling League prior to his career in long haul trucking. Fred was a member of the St. Stephen's Catholic Church, in

Hagaman.

Survivors include his wife Antoinette “Toni” Morreale Hallenbeck, whom he married on August 16, 1969; a son John (Coleen) Hallenbeck of McDonough, GA; a daughter, Holli Hallenbeck of Columbia, SC; his former foster daughters Carrie Allen of Gloversville and Ricki (Charles) Robbins of Staunton, VA; a brother Frank (Sherry) Hallenbeck of Woodbury, CT; a sister, Carol(Don) Schlect of Rockport, TX, two grandsons, Collin Ball of Johnstown and David Henderson of McDonough, GA; nephews, nieces and cousins.

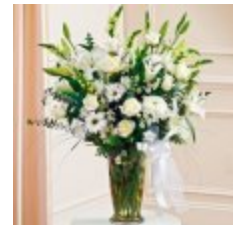

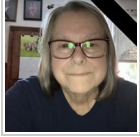

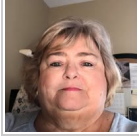
