Frederick C. "Fred" Krutz, 79, of Lakeview Road, Broadalbin passed away Saturday morning, October 9, 2021, at home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born in Schenectady on March 6, 1942, a son of Carl and Dulcie Sawyer Krutz and attended school in Scotia. Fred was a lifelong area resident and resided in Broadalbin since 1996.

Mr. Krutz was employed for the Village of Scotia and later followed in his grandfather's and father's footsteps working for the Town of Glenville Highway Department.
