Gary R. "Chobie" Culver, Jr., 47, of Reidel Road, Amsterdam passed away Sunday morning July 28, 2019 as a result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

He was born in Gloversville on July 24, 1972 a son of Gary and Joanne Liszewski Culver and attended school in Gloversville. Chobie was a 1990 graduate of Fonda-Fultonville High School. He was a lifelong area resident. Mr. Culver was employed as a truck driver at County Waste Management of Clifton Park at the time of his death.

Chobie was also a go-to handyman and was skilled in plumbing, electrical, carpentry, welding and fabrication.

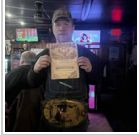
