Harold J. Hemstreet, 76, of County Highway 126, Broadalbin, died Friday morning March 4, 2016, at home following an illness.

He was born in Perth on August 10, 1939, a son of John and Hazel Kinnin Hemstreet and attended school in Perth. Mr. Hemstreet was a lifelong area resident.

Harold was employed at Price Chopper in Amsterdam for forty two years retiring as a night manager. After retiring, he returned to the produce department.
