



## Harriet G. Hemstreet

March 3, 1941 - October 1, 2016

Harriet G. Hemstreet, 75, of County Highway 126, Broadalbin, died Saturday morning October 1, 2016, at the Wilkinson Residential Health Care Facility, Amsterdam.

She was born in Amsterdam on March 3, 1941, a daughter of William and Mary Beagle Weil, and was educated in Amsterdam. Harriet was a lifelong area resident.

Harriet owned and operated Creative Styling Salon in Amsterdam for 35 years before retiring in 2010.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Mayfield. Harriet was also a member of the Hairdressers Association of New York.

She was married to Harold J. Hemstreet on December 7, 1958. He died March 4, 2016. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by two brothers, Alfred Weil and Anthony Sheckton, and a sister, Helene Budinas.
