Helen M. Gazzillo, 85, of South Clark Avenue, Gloversville died Sunday morning December 4, 2016 at Nathan Littauer Hospital.

She was born in Brooklyn on November 8, 1931 a daughter of Frank Savern and Elizabeth Johnson Trevett and moved to Gloversville at age seven. Helen was a 1949 graduate of Gloversville High School and was a lifelong city resident.

Mrs. Gazzillo was employed as a secretary at the former Bishop Burke High School and later at the Gloversville Enlarged School District, retiring in 1990. She was a communicant of the Church of the Holy Spirit and a former member of the Women's Society at church. Helen was also a former member of the 55+ Senior Citizens in Gloversville.

She enjoyed cooking for her family and loved spending time with her family and friends, especially her great-grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, Helen was predeceased by her son-in-law, David W. Herr, who died December 23, 2015.


