



## Helen Warshona

June 10, 1924 - February 11, 2017

Helen Warshona, 92, of Union Mills Road, Broadalbin died Saturday evening February 11, 2017 at Capstone Center for Rehabilitation & Nursing, Amsterdam.

She was born in Brooklyn on June 10, 1924 a daughter of Michael and Mary Zajaceskowski Mysyk and moved to Broadalbin at age 5. Helen was educated locally. She was a local resident before moving to Gouldsboro, PA where she lived for thirteen years. Mrs. Warshona returned to Broadalbin in 1980.
