Henry F. Mickan, 92, of Union Street, Broadalbin, passed away on Sunday, November 12, 2023, at the Wilkinson RHCF in Amsterdam.

He was born in Steubenville, Ohio on April 5, 1931, a son of the late William and Rose Geppel Mickan and moved to Barkersville as a child. Hank was a 1949 graduate of Saratoga High School. He moved to Broadalbin in 1960.

Mr. Mickan was employed as a truck driver and worked for the Town of Providence and Ferguson & Prokop for several years. He was also employed at Fiber Conversion in Broadalbin.

He was a veteran of the US Marines and served in the Korean War.

Hank was a member of VFW Post #8690 in Broadalbin.

He really loved the outdoors and enjoyed hunting and fishing. Hank was an avid gardener and also enjoyed traveling.

Survivors include his wife, Shirley Ferguson Mickan, whom he married on September 22, 1957; four children, Darlene (Terry) Blodgett of Perth, Robert C.
