Irwin L. Rodriguez, Jr., 40, of University Place, Amsterdam, passed away on Tuesday, April 9, 2024, at Ellis Hospital in Schenectady with his loving wife holding his hand.

He was born in Newburgh, NY on May 29, 1983, a son of Irwin and Sandra Torres Rodriguez and moved to Amsterdam as a child. Irwin attended Amsterdam High School and later FMCC. He obtained an associate degree from Excelsior College.

Mr. Rodriguez was employed as a telecom systems engineer at Excelsior University, previously known as Excelsior College, for 18 years. He also owned and operated Building 8 Media, a videography and webinar streaming service.

Irwin was one of Jehovah's Witnesses and was a member of the Kingdom Hall in Amsterdam.

Irwin was a "tech" guy and enjoyed everything related to technology. He loved golfing and traveling, especially visiting Disney World with his family.

Survivors include, his wife, Angel Childs Rodriguez, whom he married on September 16, 2006; a son, Jaiden Rodriguez; his father, Irwin (Loida) Rodriguez; his mother, Sandra Rodriguez, all of Amsterdam; two brothers, Alex (Alicia) Rodriguez of Amsterdam and Stephen (Alexis) Rodriguez of Jacksonville, FL; and many aunts, uncles, cousins and in-laws.

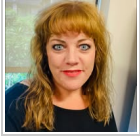
