Jacob G. Hentnik, 40, of Goodemote Road, Broadalbin, passed away at home on Tuesday, February 3, 2026.

He was born in Amsterdam on February 1, 1986, a son of Jacob and Joyce Pifko Hentnik and was a 2004 graduate of Broadalbin-Perth High School.

Jake graduated from Herkimer Community College and later received a Bachelor's in photography in Fine Arts from Virginia Intermont College.

He was employed in management at Walmart in Virginia and later transferred to Rutland, Vermont. Jake returned to Broadalbin in 2021. At the time of his death, he was employed at Kingsboro Lumber in Gloversville.

Jake was an avid hiker and loved the outdoors. He enjoyed planning hikes with friends and especially loved cooking for the adventures. Jake had 30 miles left to complete the Long Trail which begins in Massachusetts and ends in Vermont. His cousin, Jimmy Higgins, will be carrying Jake's ashes the rest of the way, completing his journey. Jake enjoyed simple life on his land, and he was a free spirit. He traveled across the country in his Subaru, venturing on no highways or toll roads. Jake also loved taking his mother to plays, movies, and concerts and enjoyed dinners that were included.

He was predeceased by his father, his paternal grandfather and Babci, Jacob and Nellie Zerbst, his maternal grandparents, George and Theodora Pifko, and his aunt and godmother, Theo Higgins.

Survivors include his mother, Joyce (Bob) Uebrick of Broadalbin; a stepbrother, Rob (Rayann) Uebrick of Salt Lake City, Utah; his beloved border

collie and devoted hiking companion, Aci May (Acadia) and her sister, Adi Sue (Adirondack); and several aunts, uncles, and cousins.
