James B. Bornt, 69, of Elmwood Avenue Extension, Gloversville died Monday morning March 14, 2016 at Nathan Littauer Hospital.

He was born in Gloversville on December 18, 1946 a son of Arthur and Helen Lake Bornt and was a 1965 graduate of Broadalbin High School. Jim was a lifelong area resident.

Mr. Bornt and his brothers have owned and operated Bornt Waste & Metal in Gloversville since 1966 and it remains family operated today.

He was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist Church in Gloversville.

Jim was a member of the Pine Tree Rifle Club. He belonged to several area bowling leagues and was also involved in area country bands for several years. Jim was an amazing bass player and he enjoyed music. He was a hard worker and loved his family deeply. Jim loved people and he was forever performing acts of kindness to help anyone in need.

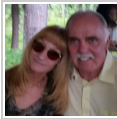

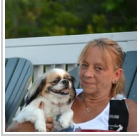

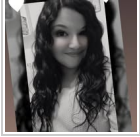
