James “Jim’ Edward Brown, 65, of Worcester, MA, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, December 7, 2023.

He was born in Gloversville on May 2, 1958, a son of the late Edward and Margaret Denison Brown, and was a 1976 graduate of Gloversville High School. Jim later graduated from Fulton Montgomery Community College with a degree in electrical technology.

He started his first job at the former Coleco Industries in Amsterdam as a technician, kickstarting a lifelong career in electronics engineering. Jim was a dedicated and diligent worker, and he advanced his career in several technology companies, living in Portland, ME and Worcester, MA. Throughout his career, Jim was able to travel the world extensively, including memorable visits to Hong Kong, Iceland, Brazil, and many places throughout Europe. At the time of his death, Jim worked at Cogmedix in Worcester, where he enjoyed his work and was happily avoiding retirement.
