James F. Canfield, 82, of County Highway 107, Fort Johnson died Sunday afternoon December 10, 2017 at Mountain Valley Hospice House, Gloversville with his loving family by his side.

He was born in Northville to Vernon and Martha Atherton Canfield and was a 1953 graduate of Northville High School. Jim was a lifelong area resident and also enjoyed spending winters in Florida.

Mr. Canfield was employed as a machinist at GE in Schenectady, retiring in 1990.
