Jeanette B. Galusha, 70, of Western Avenue, West Charlton, passed away on Monday, December 30, 2024, at Albany Medical Center.

She was born in Albany on December 12, 1954, a daughter of Joseph and Anna Madonna Cassillo and was a 1973 graduate of Mont Pleasant High School. Jeanette lived and worked in Schenectady until 1989 when she moved to West Charlton.

Mrs. Galusha was employed as a medical records clerk at Schenectady Family Health Services for nearly 10 years. She enjoyed her job and was a hard worker.

Jeanette was a member of the 1st Presbyterian Church in Ballston Spa. She also volunteered at Noah's Attic and was a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the West Charlton Fire Company and later the Galway Volunteer Fire Department. She was a member of the Ballston Spa Senior Citizens.

Jeanette enjoyed crocheting, woodworking with her husband, and selling their creations at local craft shows.

She married Raymond Galusha on April 22, 1989. He died on July 22, 2018. In addition to her husband and parents, Jeanette was predeceased by a brother, Joseph Cassillo, Jr.
