Jeannine was born in Amsterdam on May 22, 1951, a daughter of George and Marian Korrow White, of Johnstown, and was a 1969 graduate of Johnstown High School. In 1973, she received a Bachelor's degree in Art from SUNY at Plattsburgh. For the past twenty-nine years, Jeannine lived in Caroga Lake. Mrs. Schwartz was employed as a swimming instructor at the Fulton County YMCA in Johnstown. Previously, she was the waterfront director with the Girls Scouts at Wood Haven for several years. She was affectionately known as "Waterlily" at the camp.

When her children were young, Jeannine was involved with the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts. She also volunteered at their school with the marching band and winter guard.

Jeannine was a member of the Nick Stoner Seniors and was a former member of the Christ Lutheran Church in Johnstown.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by a daughter, Christine. Survivors include her husband, John C. Schwartz, whom she married on September 8, 1973; three children, John (Kristen) Schwartz II of Merrimack, NH, Daniel (Nicole) Schwartz of Whitsett, NC, and Virginia Schwartz of Oceanside, CA; her twin sister, Dianne Mitchell of Kinderhook; a brother, Kenneth White of Johnstown; two sisters-in-law, Mary Schwartz of Scotia and Sr. Anne Schwartz OP of Bardonia, NY; and three grandchildren.
