Joan R. Coolidge, 76, of G Burdick Road, Gloversville died Tuesday morning August 16, 2016 at home surrounded by her loving family.

She was born in Gloversville on September 30, 1939 a daughter of Lawrence and Margaret Blood Chamberlain and was a lifelong area resident. Joan attended elementary school in a one-room school house in Peck's Lake and was a 1957 graduate of Gloversville High School.

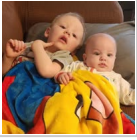
