John A. Albanese, 64, of Gloversville, son of the late Mr. Attilio Albanese and C. Albanese, passed away at home on Tuesday, May 30, 2023, after a long illness with his family at his side.

He was born in Gloversville on February 4, 1959, and moved to Springfield, Vermont as a child. John was a 1978 graduate of Springfield High School and later graduated from UMass at Stockbridge. He moved to Johnstown, NY in 1993 and lived in the town of Mayfield since 1996.

Growing up, John worked with his father establishing the Crown Point County Club in Springfield, VT as well as the Alban Hills Country Club (now Fox Run) in Johnstown.
