John T. Ligon, Jr., 71, of Santos Drive, Gloversville, passed away peacefully at home on Wednesday, December 17, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. Born in Gloversville on March 11, 1954, the son of John and Ellen Pollard Ligon, John was a lifelong resident of the community he cherished. A 1972 graduate of Gloversville High School, he excelled as a standout athlete in football, basketball, and baseball. His passion for sports continued beyond high school, as he played football for the Glove City Colonials from 1974 to 1984, earning a place in the team's Hall of Fame. He also enjoyed playing fast-pitch softball in Mecó and was an enthusiastic member of several local bowling leagues.

John dedicated many years of service to Niagara Mohawk in Gloversville before embarking on a career as a long-haul truck driver with Washburn's Dairy and Finkle Distributors. Known for his warm personality and generous spirit, he was a familiar face in the community and treasured time spent with family and friends. He was a member of the People's A.M.E. Zion Church in Gloversville.

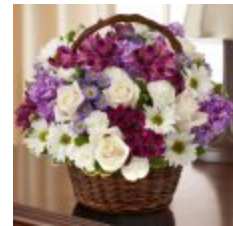
