John W. "Jack" Michell, 81, of South Shore Road, Northville died Monday January 8, 2018 at St. Johnsville Rehab. & Nursing Center.

He was born in Ozone Park, NY on March 16, 1936 a son of John and Ina Bovee Michell and moved upstate as a child. Jack attended school in Broadalbin. He resided on South Shore Road and later moved to Arizona. Jack returned to New York in 2006.

In 1966, he co-owned and -operated the former Old Lonesome Lodge in North Broadalbin where he met and fell in love with the love of his life, Nancy. They spent 51 wonderful years together.
