



## Joseph W. Cardone, Sr.

Joseph W. Cardone, Sr., 92 formerly of Bellerose, NY died Monday afternoon December 7, 2015 at the Fulton Center for Rehab & Healthcare with his family at his side.

He was born in Brooklyn on January 22, 1923 and was educated in New York City. Mr. Cardone lived in Queens for most of his life before moving to Broadalbin last September.
